Annual. Full sun 75-95 days Very large fruit up to 2lbs each Yellow with red marbling throughout flesh Very sweet and fruity, good yields



Fireworks Fountain Grass

Pennisetum setaceum 'Fireworks' Annual, Full to part sun 3 ft H x 2 ft W Colorful, upright growth; variegated stripes of white, green, burgundy and hot pink run length of the blade



*Origanum x hybrida '*Kirigami' Annual, Full sun 8-10 in H x 12-14 in W Non-culinary; large purple-green bracts & rose flowers Delicious fragrance attracts pollinators

Capsicum annuum Annual. Full sun 4-5 in H x 6-8 in W Small, round purple and orange peppers make a high impact display, can be eaten but not palatable, very hot





Night Sky Petunia Annual, Full sun

10-13 in H x 20-30 in W Starry white-on-purple pattern sparkles like the night sky. As outdoor temperatures change, so do the number of speckles.

Houseplant, Full sun to part shade 18-24 in H x 18-24 in W, Consistent moisture Leaves close when touched, Prune to shape Children's favorite plant in the Sun Garden!

Passiflora 'Incense' Annual vine, Full to part sun 6-10 ft H x 5-8 ft W, Zone 6-10 Medium moisture, Attracts butterflies

Blueberry Muffin Carpet Bugle Ajuga 'Blueberry Muffin' Perennial, Full to partial sun 6 in H x 28 in W, Zone 5-9

Deep blue blooms in spring, keep soil evenly moist Faster/stronger grower, thick weather resistant leaves




Golden Columbine

Aquilegia chrysantha Perennial, Full to part sun 2-3 ft H x 2-3 ft W, Zone 3-9 Well drained soil, even moisture throughout season Native to mountainous regions in the Southwest

Thumbell Blue Bellflower Campanula rotundifolia 'Thumbell Blue' Perennial, Partial (afternoon) shade 8 in H x 10-12in W, Zone 4-8

Native; All soil types, well-drained and average water Tidy; Blooms for months late spring to late summer

Lady Fern

Athyrium filix-femina Perennial, Partial to full shade 1-3 ft H x 1-2.5 ft W. Zone 4-8 Grow in rich, medium moisture soils; Will tolerate drier if shaded, sun if constantly moist



Whirling Butterflies

Gaura lindheimeri 'Whirling Butterflies' Perennial, Full sun 2-3 ft H x 2-3 ft W, Zone 5-9 Red stems, pink bud, 1" white flowers May-Sept Tolerates heat, humidity, drought; Well drained soil

Northern Exposure Lime Coral Bells Heuchera 'Northern Exposure Lime' Perennial, Partial to full shade 14-16 in H x 20-21 in W, Zone 4-9 Normal/sandy, average/moist soil; Chartreuse leaves Deer/rabbit resistant; Blooms red early summer

Maltese Cross Lychnis chalcedonica

Perennial, Full sun 35-47 in H x 12-18 in W, Zone 2-9 Blooms orange in summer; Average-wet, all soil types Attracts butterflies; Deer/rabbit resistant; Good cut

Sugar Buzz Bubblegum Blast Bee Balm Monarda 'Bubblegum Blast' Perennial, Full to part sun

21-23 in H x 27-31 in W, Zone 4-9 Shaggy, hot pink flowers; Leaf mint smell when crushed Deer/Rabbit/Drought resistant; Attracts pollinators


Phlox paniculata 'David'

Perennial, Full or partial sun 35-39 in H x 23-29 in W, Zone 3-9 Sweet fragrance; superb for cutting, MidSum-Early Fall All soil types, average-moist water Attracts butterflies, Resists Deer/Powdery Mildew

Running with Scissors Creeping Phlox Perennial, Full or sun 4-6 in H x 12-18 in W, Zone 4-9

Named for strong cleft, blunt petals like safety scissors Prefers normal-sandy soil, low moisture Flowers up to 6 weeks early spring, may rebloom in fall





Raspberry Splash Lungwart Pulmonaria 'Raspberry Splash' Perennial, Part to full shade (summer sun burns leaves) 9-12 in H x 12-18 in W, Zone 4-9 Soil must not dry out, Blooms April

Perennial, Full to part sun 23-29 in H x 18-23 in W, Zone 3-9 Upright clump, profuse brown-eyed, gold-orange daisies Attracts pollinators; Resists deer/rabbits; Average water

Salvia nemorosa 'Bumbleberry'

Perennial, Full sun 10-12 in H x 12-14 in W, Zone 3-8 Dark fuchsia pink flowers on dark wine purple calyxes Md-low water; attracts pollinators; Resists deer/rabbits Small, compact size is perfect for front of the border

Sunsparkler[®] Lime Zinger Sedum



Perennial, Full sun 4 in H x 18 in W, Zone 4-9 Very hardy succulent groundcover; fantastic lime green leaves edged in bright cherry red Soft pink flowers in late summer; drought resistant



Sedum hybrid PARTY HARDY™ Series Perennial, Full sun 14-18 in H x 24 in W, Zone 4-9 Compact round habit, light pink flowers & blue foliage Late Summer/Fall blooming; Low water, good drainage

Perennial, Full sun 36-40 in H x 24 in W, Zone 4-9 Md rosettes with rosy-red to silvery-blue leaves Color varies with temp changes; Drought tolerant

Stachys officinalis 'Hummelo' Perennial of the Year 2019! Perennial, Full sun,






Staff Favorites

Perennial, Full Sun, Bloom Summer 10-12 in H x 10-12 in W, Zones 5-9 Creamy white, feathery flowers with red stems, Sandy/average soil, dry water needs Attracts butterflies/hummingbirds, Deer resistant





Moulin Rouge Fleming Hardy Hibiscus Hibiscus x moscheutos 'Moulin Rouge' Kari Campbell, Rental Manager "I love hibiscus for its big, bright, beautiful flowers."

Perennial, Full to part sun 3-4 ft H x 3.5 ft W, Zones 4 Bright 10" red flowers Attracts pollinators



Green Twister Coneflower Echinacea purpurea 'Green Twister' **Dave Searl, Head Gardener**

"Stunning to look at and irresistible to butterflies! This unique color combination will be an eyecatcher in anybody's perennial border." Perennial, Full to part sun 35-39 in H x 13-14 in W, Zones 4-9

Yellow-green bleeds into pale lilac-pink center petals All soil types and moisture levels; Great cut flowers Attracts Butterflies/hummingbirds; Deer Resistant



Brise D'Anjou Jacob's Ladder Polemonium caeruleum

"I enjoy the ladder-like leaves and it brightens up shady areas nicely." Perennial, Partial shade 12-18 in H x 10-12 in W. Zones 3-9 Deep blue flowers, green & cream fern-like leaves All soils; Average/moist water, Blooms early summer Attracts butterflies, Deer Resistant



Annual, Full to part sun 12-20 in H x 12 in W Soft, tufted flower heads in summer Tolerates sandy soil and dry conditions Good for ornamental plantings, container growing



English Lavender Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote Blue' Sarah Balkovek, Accounting

Tender Perennial, Full sun, Bloom Mid Summer 12-18 in H x 12-18 in W, Zones 5-8 Deep purple flowers, good cut or dried Needs good drainage and sheltered winter location Attracts Butterflies; Deer/Rabbit/Drought Tolerant Prune back to 8" in spring every 3 years Does not like high humidity, use rock mulch
